Are you doing messy play at home and looking for ways to expand messy play?

Below are 6 ways to expand messy play

- 1 HIDE ITEMS INSIDE SLIME/DOUGH
- 2 INSPIRE IMAGINATION WITH "I WONDER" STATEMENTS

I wonder what creatures can be made / what adventure we are going on / what we will find on our adventure

- 3 FOLLOW THE CHILD'S LEAD WITH THEME/PLAY AND EXPAND
 - If a current interest is camping can a tent be built around the table and food and bugs be made of play dough?
 - Make potions in the backyard or bathroom
 - Use nature rocks / grass / dirt, make sand soup and dirt pasta
- GO ON AN ADVENTURE THROUGH THE HOUSE TO FIND INGREDIENTS
 - Pretend to fly through the galaxy to locate items
 - Hop and crawl like different animals to find ingredients
- 5 READ A BOOK RELATED TO MESSY PLAY
 - Bartholomew and The Oobleck
 - Cloudy with a Chance of Meatballs
 - Pete the Cat I love my White Shoes
- **USE MUSIC/ SINGING SONGS**
 - Sing Itsy Bitsy spider during water play or fizzy painting
 - Paint to different speeds of music
